An update from Glebe Farm School Project

Welcome to Morgan Sindall's Introduction to Glebe Farm School Project.



Project Overview

Glebe farm school is an all through school that Morgan Sindall's Northern Home Counties office has been selected to deliver by Milton Keynes Council. We commenced construction on 23rd February 2021 and are due to hand the completed school over on September 2022.

The schools structure consists of steel frame and precast planks to floors plates with a mixture of various types of cladding to finish the external look of the building. There will also be a sports hall and a multi use games area as well as a number of Sport England pitches.

Project Update

Since starting on site on 23rd February we will be focussing on installing our haul road for deliveries as well as commencing a soft strip of the vegetation that is on the ground. Over the next few weeks we will be starting the cut and fill exercise to the building footprint and starting foundations for the school on the 8th March. Currently the structural steelwork is due to start being erected on 26th April.
