An update from Glebe Farm School Project

Welcome to Morgan Sindall's monthly newsletter for the Glebe Farm School Project.



Project Overview

The Glebe Farm School project is an all through school delivered by Morgan Sindall Northern Home Counties office for Milton Keynes Council.

The school build consists of the steel frame, precast concrete planks, and a mixture of cladding, curtain walling and brickwork. It has been designed to create a modern, sustainable look.

We commenced construction on 23rd February 2021 and are due to hand the completed school over in September 2022.

Project Update

We are now beginning to see the buildings frame turn into an enclosed envelope with the installation of the windows, SFS and boarding in full swing.

Over the course of the last month we have been installing drainage across the site, preparing the newly built substation for power and continuing to concrete the internal planks and rebar to form the floors.

In total there are 7 different roof levels on this project, all are currently being worked on to provide water tight internals ready for next months works!

What's happening next month

Over the course of the next month we will be continuing to install windows, moving onto external doors, cladding and curtain walling!

First fix for Mechanical & Electrical services and Drylining will be commencing, along with decorations to the soffit and seeding the sports pitches.

Within October we will be completing the concrete pour to the Ground Floor, and getting started on brickwork!
